### Who May Apply

PLEASE DO NOT SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION UNTIL THE POSTED FILING DATE.

The City of Fresno will be accepting applications for Firefighter Trainee beginning OCTOBER 26, through NOVEMBER 2, 2015.

### Minimum Requirements:

- High School diploma or GED;
- MUST be at least 20 years of age to apply, MUST be 21 years of age and have a valid California driver's license at time of appointment;
- MUST possess a current and valid EMT Certificate;
- MUST possess a California State Fire Marshal Firefighter 1 certification OR have completed a basic Fire Academy;
- MUST possess a current CPR card which meets American Heart Association Guidelines; and
- MUST possess a current CPAT card prior to Fire Chief's interview.

Documentation proving possession of the necessary qualifications will be required at time of department interview, so now is the ideal time to start gathering your documents.
