- Perform audits of training programs, service providers, and hospitals;
- Participate in public education campaigns such as Hands-Only CPR;

- Participates in system-wide quality improvement activities;
- Investigate complaints regarding pre-hospital care provided by field personnel;
- Liaison between field personnel, hospital emergency room personnel, County public service departments, EMS agencies and committees and private EMS providers;
- Conducts training for first responder field personnel, MICNs, and dispatchers;
- EMS On-Call for after-hours support during incidents, hospital support, and system coordination.
