INITIAL CERTIFICATION §100079 (a)(1)(A) and (a)(1)(B)		
<p>(a)(1)(A) : Pass the NREMT written and skills exam and possess a valid EMT course completion record or other documented proof of successful completion of any initial EMT course (pursuant to §100066 of this chapter) within the last two (2) years</p> <p style="text-align: center;">OR</p> <p>(a)(1)(B) : Pass the NREMT written and skills exam and possess documentation of successful completion of an approved out-of -state initial EMT training course which meets the requirements of this chapter within the last two (2) years</p>	DATES	EXAMPLE:
	<p>Issue: The day application/requirements are completed and processed by LEMSA/Cert Entity</p> <p>Effective: The day certificate is issued</p> <p>Expiration: The last day of the month two (2) years from the effective date of initial certification</p>	<p>06/01/2014</p> <p>06/01/2014</p> <p>06/30/2016</p>
INITIAL CERTIFICATION §100079 (a)(1)(C), (a)(2), (a)(3) and (a)(4)		
<p>(a)(1)(C): Pass the NREMT written and skills exam and possess a current and valid out-of-state EMT certificate</p> <p style="text-align: center;">OR</p> <p>(a)(2): Possess a current and valid NREMT Basic registration certificate</p> <p style="text-align: center;">OR</p> <p>(a)(3): Possess a current and valid out-of-state or NREMT Intermediate or Paramedic certificate</p> <p style="text-align: center;">OR</p> <p>(a)(4): Possess a current and valid CA AEMT or EMT-II certification or a current and valid CA Paramedic license</p>	DATES	EXAMPLE:
	<p>Issue: The day application/requirements are completed and processed by LEMSA/Cert Entity</p> <p>Effective: The day certificate is issued</p> <p>Expiration: The last day of the month two (2) years from the effective date of initial certification</p> <p style="text-align: center;">OR</p> <p>The expiration date of the certificate or license used to establish eligibility under Subdivision (a)</p> <p>***The expiration date shall be the lesser of the two dates. (In the example, a Paramedic license was used for EMT certification on 06/01/2014, but the Paramedic license expires on 03/31/2015, so the lesser date is used)</p>	<p>06/01/2014</p> <p>06/01/2014</p> <p>06/31/2016</p> <p>03/31/2015</p>

RECERTIFICATION §100080 (a)(1)(2)

<p>(a)(1)(2): Possess a current EMT certification in CA, Obtain at least twenty-four (24) continuing education (CE) hours from an approved CE provider (pursuant to Chapter 11) or successfully complete a twenty-four (24) hour refresher course from an approved EMT training program. A completed skills competency form (EMSA-SCV (08/10)) is also required for EMT recertification</p> <p>An individual who is currently licensed in CA as a Paramedic or certified as an AEMT, or EMT-II, or who has been certified within six (6) months of the date of application may be given credit for CEs earned as a Paramedic, AEMT or EMT-II to satisfy the CE requirement for EMT recertification.</p> <p>A CA certified EMT who is a member of the Armed Forces of the US, and whose certification expires less than 6 (six) months from the date they return from active duty deployment with the Armed Forces of the US, shall have 6 (six) months from the date he/she returns to complete the requirements of §100080 (a)(2) – (a)(5). The EMT must submit proof of membership in the Armed Forces in the US and documentation of their deployment start and end dates in order to qualify for this exception.</p>	<p align="center">DATES</p> <p>If the EMT recertification requirements are met within six (6) months prior to current certification expiration date: Effective: The day after the expiration date of the current certificate.</p> <p>Expiration: The certification will expire every two (2) years from the day prior to the effective date</p> <p>-----</p> <p>If the EMT recertification requirements are met greater than six (6) months prior to the current certification expiration date: Effective: The date the recruit successfully completed all requirements and has applied for recertification.</p> <p>Expiration: The certification will expire the last day of the month two (2) years from the effective date</p>	<p>EXAMPLE:</p> <p>Current exp.: 05/31/2015</p> <p>New eff.: 06/01/2015</p> <p>New exp.: 05/31/2017</p> <p>-----</p> <p>Current exp.: 05/31/2015</p> <p>New eff.: 11/15/2014</p> <p>New exp.: 11/30/2016</p>
