What works for you

- ▣ Each LEMSA needs to determine what works for their system
- ▣ We are much further ahead than I thought in LA and State-wide

- ▣ LA County made a conscious decision to allow providers to choose their systems
- ▣ We have a policy that stipulates that the system must integrate with Lancet Technology Inc.
- ▣ Other specifications in policy
- ▣ Recently - high level steering committee of stakeholders (should have done sooner)

- ▣ We have over 10 million records with over 200 data elements per record
- ▣ Data base with outcomes from our specialty center programs
- ▣ Single patient care record is an issue for everyone
- ▣ Cradle to grave concept

Lancet Technology Inc. recently linked all of the independent records to create a single record per patient

- EMS
- Base
- Trauma
- STEMI/ROSCI/Stroke

Control and Ownership of Data

- ▣ Critical to us – ability to mine the data
 - System monitoring
 - Reporting
 - Able to do this by having field data going to Lancet Technology Inc. program
