Epinephrine Auto-injector Certification Application

The following currently licensed California health care professionals are deemed to have met the requirement for training and are eligible to apply to the Emergency Medical Services Authority for certification: physicians, physician assistants, registered nurses, and currently licensed or certified California paramedics and advanced emergency medical technicians.

The following prehospital emergency medical care personnel who have successfully completed training in the administration of epinephrine by auto-injector, approved by a local EMS agency or the EMS Authority, are eligible for certification: emergency medical technicians, lifeguards, firefighters and peace officers.
